Sexual practices among Two-spirit, Gay, Bisexual, and Queer men of different HIV statuses in Manitoba

RATIONALE & OBJECTIVE

- 2SGBQM in Manitoba remain one of the most vulnerable populations for HIV, and other sexually transmitted and blood-borne infections (STBBI).
- This study examined the relationship between self-reported HIV status and HIV sexual risk behaviours among Two-Spirit, gay, bisexual, queer and other men who have sex with men (2SGBQM) men in Manitoba.





METHODOLOGY

Data were drawn from a community-based, Manitoba-wide online survey of 2SGBQM (age 18+).

Eligibility:

- Identify as a man (cisgender or transgender).
- Report any sex with another man in the previous 12 months or identify as 2SGBQM.
- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Live or work in Manitoba.

Recruitment and Sampling:

Participants for the survey were recruited in Winnipeg, Brandon, and Thompson, and other locations across Manitoba using printed flyers ,CBOs, social media, and website <u>www.manitobamenshealthstudy.com</u>

Statistical Analyses

Chi-square analyses and logistic regression were used to examine the relationships between HIV status and sexual risk behaviours.

RESULTS

- 1. Among 300 2SGBQM, 72 (24%) reported living with HIV, 8 (2.7%) were unsure, and 220 (73.3%) were HIV-negative.
- 2. 2SGBQM living with HIV in Manitoba were more likely to bottom without using a condom with a partner whose HIV status was unknown than HIV-negative 2SGBQM (22% versus 10% respectively) (χ 2=6.506, p<.05).
- 3. 2SGBQM living with HIV were also more likely to bottom condomless with a male HIV-positive partner whose viral load they did not know (27.8% versus 4.5% for HIV-negative men) (χ 2=31.642, p<.001), and to top condomless with an HIV-positive partner whose viral load they did not know (27.8% versus 4.5% for HIV-negative men) (χ 2=35.803, p<.001).
- 4. There were no differences in the proportion reporting condomless anal intercourse with a detectable partner when bottoming (4.2%, p=0.614) or topping (0%, p=0.397).

FINDINGS & DISCUSSION

- 1. The findings show that HIV-positive 2SGBQM in Manitoba are engaged in serosorting and strategic positioning.
- 2. Future research needs to examine how 2SGBQM take their sexual partners' HIV viral load into account during sex.
- 3. Health promotion for HIV combination prevention strategies should continue to ensure 2SGBQM are aware of a variety of preventive practices to optimize their sexual health. Thank you!
